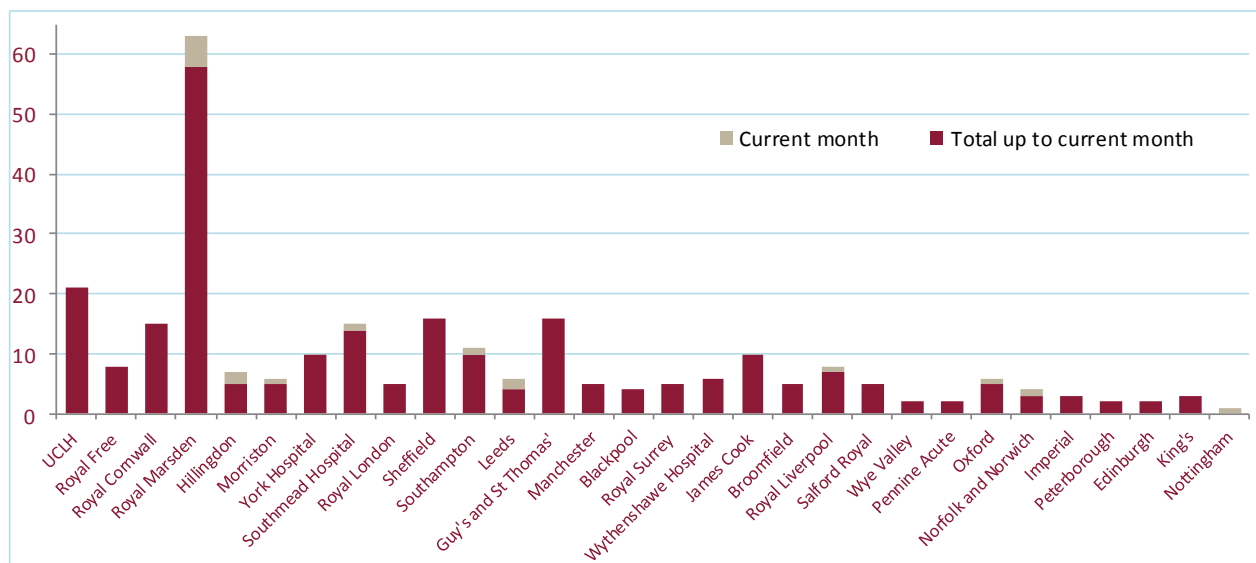
PREVENTT News

Welcome to the latest edition of the PREVENTT newsletter. Firstly, during July, the trial was awarded further funding for a two year extension. This will allow recruitment to be completed and is based on a monthly recruitment target of 10 patients per month. The new end date for recruitment is now 31/08/2018.

All sites have received an invitation to the next investigator meeting which will be held on 29th September at the Wellcome Trust in London. One of the aims of this meeting will be to identify the best ways sites can be supported for the next two years.
