

It is an exciting time for PREVENTT as we have moved into the next phase of the trial.

The next focus will be to gather the follow up data for the trial, so we will be working really closely with sites over the next couple of months so that is collected in a timely manner. Please contact Laura Van Dyck

The study closure date is the 31st August 2019 so it is important that the six month data is completed to schedule by June 2019. We plan to organise some teleconference calls and set up some visits to sites to see how that is going. Please let us know if you would like us to visit. For those sites that have completed follow-up we will be in touch about closing out soon.
